Jerry is teaching "Introduction to the Bible" to first year students and Sherri is teaching "Christian Education" to second year students. Last month Sherri also began teaching English to the students and staff. Their Sunday services have really been good. One Sunday nine students came forward to ask Jesus into their lives. Recently they hosted a medical team for ten days. The team was able to see students, staff, and people from the nearby villages, not only addressing their physical needs but spiritual too. This resulted in seventeen people saying "Yes" to Jesus! Currently they have a mission team from Michigan working on campus. With so many new students this year and rising costs, they are in desperate need of sponsors for students. Jerry recommends reading a couple of books: *The Hole in Our Gospel* by Richard Stearns and *The Disciple Making Pastor* by Bill Hull. They write, "We always want to say thank you to those of you who are faithful to pray for us and our ministry here in Honduras. 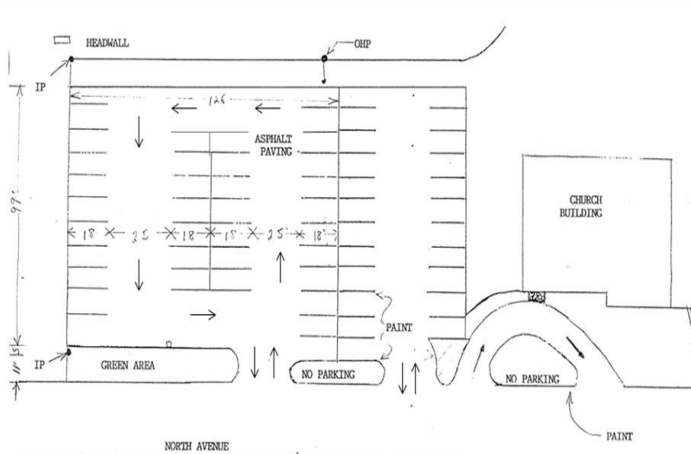
Baptism and Reception of New Members – April 17
