**Rev 1:3** *Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near. NKJV*

**Do you remember that word “Blessed”?** In the 5<sup>th</sup> chapter of Matthew Jesus uses the word blessed nine times. Here in Revelation 1:3 the Greek word “*Makarios*” is used to describe what will happen to those souls that read and hear the words of Revelation and then choose to keep or obey the instruction in this book

### Murphys

### Orellanas

Kim, Guido, and girls are scheduled to return to Ecuador on January 28. They are headed for Florida working on some possible meetings to help raise the rest of their financial support. They are nearly fully funded. Although excited to be returning they know there will be some sad days of saying goodbyes. Please pray for their safe return. ### Eldhos

We received our first quarterly field report about our missionary family, Matt and Mini Eldho and their children, in India. They are serving faithfully with other missionaries in Kerala. In this region this quarter 13,308 tracts were distributed, 2,079 families were visited, 116 people came to the Lord, 75 villages were reached by the film on the life of Jesus, 2 Bio-Sand Water Filters were distributed, and 1 Bridge of Hope Center helped to educate 98 students who are among Asia's poorest children. Please pray for them as they continue to touch lives for the Lord in their part of our world.

## Haiti Mission Trip

Our Haiti Mission trip has been delayed due to civil unrest there. We hope to reschedule the trip sometime in May. Pray for the Lord's guidance and stay tuned.
