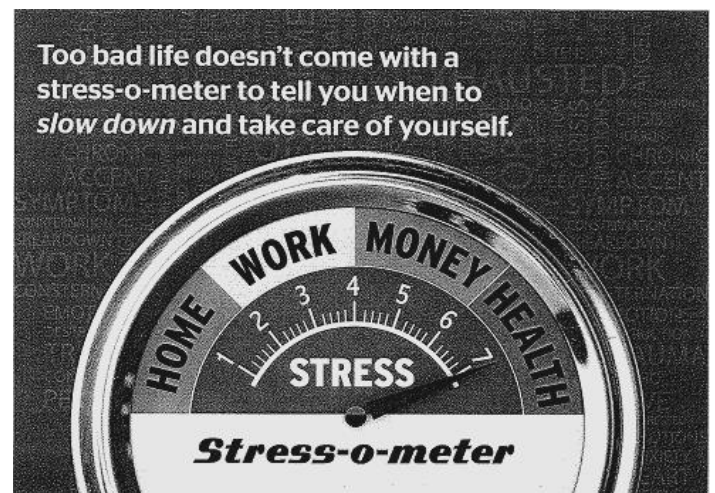

I have to confess, though, I did a little whining at small group when I thought of revival lasting for five nights this time. After all, Lord, I’m very busy with my work, family, community, and church! When would I get my much needed (and pretty regimented) sleep time? My stress level began to soar! So God dealt with me again the very next morning! My husband, Dave, received a card in the mail from the State of Ohio regarding a Health Coach program they are offering called *Take Charge Live Well*. Guess what the topic was? Stress reduction! The front of the card stated “*Too bad life doesn’t come with a stress-o-meter to tell you when to slow down and take care of yourself*”. It also came with a picture of a **Stress-o-meter** showing increasing stress levels with home, work, money, and health. The back of the card provided tips on stress reduction by focusing on breathing, exercise, eating healthy, getting enough sleep, prioritizing, and talking out our stressors. God knew He had to help me put things back into perspective!



Isn’t that what He does every day through our prayer time, studying His word and our personal relationship with Him? He is an awesome Health Coach! He created this physical body and gave me His spirit to intercede for me! He directs us individually by identifying our talents, strengths, weaknesses, and then places us strategically in a team of all generations to prompt us toward a shared goal. He emphasizes the importance of unity and working together with one purpose... eternal life with Him! I know revival **has** to start within me, but I hope you will all join my team with the **Almighty Health Coach** as we anticipate a powerful time of renewal and strengthening. Get prayed up and spend some time with God in training! I’ll see you next Sunday, October 3 through Thursday, October 7 at Christ Church and God will meet us there!
